



MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

Association Rules and Policies

All Kapolioka'ehukai Outrigger Canoe Club (Kapolioka'ehuka) members:

1. Shall have all required Kapolioka'ehuka forms and waivers signed and submitted to and Kapolioka'ehuka Committee members prior to any paddling practice or use of club equipment.
2. Shall pay Kapolioka'ehuka dues to the Treasurer as scheduled by the Board. **Make checks payable to Kapolioka'ehukai Outrigger Canoe Club.**
3. Shall comply with all scheduling, crew selection, or any other organization decisions made by the Kapolioka'ehuka coaching staff.
4. Shall disclose and inform Kapolioka'ehuka coaches of any and all limitations, medical and mental health conditions, use of medications (see below) and promise to inform Kapolioka'ehuka of any changes throughout the year.
5. Shall assist with equipment upkeep, race preparation, and Kapolioka'ehuka fundraising efforts.
6. Shall NOT assume to borrow, possess, loan out, or "take command" of any equipment or assets that Kapolioka'ehuka either owns or is responsible for, without the expressed permission of either the Kapolioka'ehuka Head Coach or the Kapolioka'ehuka President.
7. Shall respect all Kapolioka'ehuka equipment and the rights and private property of all Kapolioka'ehuka members at all times.
8. Members will be required to Volunteer a minimum of THREE community outreach events
9. Members will be required to Volunteer for the End of Season Club Fundraiser, which features Rell Sunn Movie screening.
10. Members may be held liable for any violation of the Kapolioka'ehuka bylaws.

Terms

All Kapolioka'ehukai Outrigger Canoe Club (Kapolioka'ehuka) members:

1. This Membership Agreement shall be valid only as long as the paddler remains in good financial standing and complies with all Kapolioka'ehuka rules and policies as outlined in this document and the Kapolioka'ehuka Bylaws.
2. Causes for ineligibility to race:
 - a. The member is delinquent in dues or race fees.
 - b. The member is suspended by the Committee for misconduct during any Club function or race, which directly reflects on the reputation and image of Kapolioka'ehuka.
 - c. The member fails to meet established insurance requirements.
 - d. Failure to sign Kapolioka'ehuka required forms.
3. Causes for termination of the Membership Agreement:
 - a. Failure to pay Kapolioka'ehuka dues.
 - a. Failure to comply with the Kapolioka'ehuka Bylaws.
 - b. Any gross insubordination or disrespect shown toward any Kapolioka'ehuka member, Kapolioka'ehuka Committee officer, or the SCORA organization.
